Species Notes:

Harlequin Ducks: Descent numbers within Yellowstone Park reported from LeHardy Rapids off Grand Loop Rd. north of Fishing Bridge.

White-tailed Ptarmigan: Rocky Mountain NP – Trail Ridge Rd.

Neotropic Cormorant: Seen in the vicinity of SLC for the past few years. Not specifically seen at Antelope or Bear River MBR.

Flammulated Owl: Frequently seen south of SLC off Alpine Loop Rd. and Timpooneke Rd. Nocturnal ONLY. Great Gray Owl: Yellowstone Area; seen infrequently in the area, breeds in the area. Seen during the day as well as early morning or late evening.
